6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to immunizations; prohibiting infant  
8 from being immunized without consent; requiring  
9 consent at certain time; requiring State Board of  
Health to promulgate certain rules; and providing an  
effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-502A of Title 63, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A newborn infant shall not be immunized without the written  
17 consent of the parent. Consent shall be obtained at the time of  
18 immunization and may not be obtained prior to immunization of the  
19 child.

20 The State Board of Health shall promulgate rules to implement  
21 the provisions of this section.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
